# ADVANCED PLACEMENT Summer institutes

With an initiative to increase the number of Advanced Placement (AP\*) teachers in the state of Illinois, the University of Illinois System will be hosting an Advanced Placement Summer Institute (APSI) in 2025 in partnership with the College Board\* at the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign.

The APSI is a College Board-endorsed 30-hour training program for high school teachers. U of I System APSIs are designed for new AP teachers or those AP teachers with minimal training from school districts with AP Exam Participation of less than 20 percent. The APSIs will focus on these subjects: English Language & Composition, English Literature & Composition, U.S. History, and Psychology. Teachers may earn up to 30 hours of professional development through the Illinois State Board of Education upon successful completion.

The U of I System will cover the full cost of tuition\* for those teachers from school districts with AP Exam Participation of less than 20 percent. If you are interested in this APSI or would like to see if your district qualifies for free tuition, email us at UllinoisAPSI@uillinois.edu. Once registration opens, early in 2025, we will notify you about how to register. Note: a refundable deposit will be required to reserve a place in the APSI. **Spots are limited.** Other Illinois teachers are welcome to participate at the tuition rates noted below.
